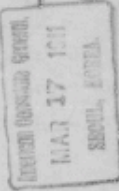


Chunju, Korea, March 11th, 1911.

Dear Sir:

In compliance with your instructions I enclose an inventory of the effects of the late Miss Laura May Pitts, together with an estimated value of each article. Most of her things were just out from America and had not been used at all, and we were able to find accurate values on those items, but in other cases we had to only estimate what the various articles were worth.

I also enclose separately a list of those things which we think were of sentimental value and should be returned to her relatives. These articles are also included in the general list.

I do not know what the law requires but if her things are to be sold it is more than likely that most of the furniture and some of the other articles could be disposed of here at Chunju, and thus save the trouble and expense of shipping them to Seoul. Kindly let me know if this will be allowed.

As I wrote you in my first letter we should like very much if things could be left until word can be heard from her relatives. I should appreciate it very much if you would, as I requested, let me know just what is to be done with her effects.

Also will you please send me in your next letter a form for making out a will?
